In early October, Porto has mild autumn weather with daytime highs around 20°C and nighttime lows near 12°C. Rainfall increases to about 121 mm over 10–15 days, humidity rises to 79%, and the UV index remains moderate, so expect a mix of sunny and rainy periods.

Getting Around Porto

Arriving in Porto

Most international delegates will arrive at **Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (OPO)**, located approximately 13 km from the city center. Porto's public transportation system offers a fast and affordable way to reach your accommodation or the conference venue.

From the Airport to the Venue

The easiest and most convenient option is the Metro do Porto.

- Take Line E (Purple) from the airport.
- Disembark at Casa da Música station, from there, it's just a 10-minute walk to the Porto Palácio Hotel & Congress Center.
- The journey takes around 30 minutes.
- Taxis and ride-sharing apps (like Bolt and Uber) are also readily available at the airport.

Getting Around the City

Porto is a very walkable city, with most key sights and restaurants within short distances. Public buses, trams, and metro lines provide excellent coverage throughout the city.

Tip: Consider purchasing an <u>Andante card</u> for convenient travel across all public transport modes.
